Competition Rules

1. Children must be the age of their class or under on Monday 6th May 2024.
2. Class 16/17 – The photograph must be mounted on card no bigger than A4.
3. Class 18 – **Must be an original piece of work by the entrant.**
4. Class 19/20 – Any item or picture that is homemade including knitting, Woodwork, crochet, pottery, drawing. – not exceeding A3 if mounted.
5. A Competition Entry form must accompany all entries; this can be found within this schedule or available on the day.
6. **All entries must be your own work; the judges' decisions are final**
7. Unnamed entries will not be accepted. Please fix your name firmly to your exhibit where it **cannot** be seen by the judges.
8. All competition entries must be collected between 4 and 5pm on Monday 6th May 2024 from the Ifield Barn Arts Centre. After this time entries may be disposed of at the discretion of the Ifield Mayfayre Committee.
9. Trophies must be returned in April 2025
10. Entry fees applicable. Children's entries are free, the family and adult classes are £1 per entry.
 - ❖ There will be rosettes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each class.

Entries will be accepted on Sunday 5th May from 2pm - 4pm and on Monday 6th May from 9am – 10am. It would be appreciated if you could make every effort to bring your entries on SUNDAY - Ifield Barn Theatre is very busy on the morning of the Fayre and it helps us to display your exhibits to their best advantage, and NO vehicular access is available on MONDAY at any point.

Judging will commence sharply at 10.30am on the morning of the May Fayre, therefore we will not be able to accept entries after 10am.

Entrants are not permitted in the Exhibition Hall until 11:30am. Presentation of the prizes will take place outside the main entrance of the Ifield Barn Theatre in the afternoon.
