PALM CROSSES


A basket is on the table for the return of last year's palm cross to make ash for Ash Wednesday (18th February) – the basket will be available until Sunday 1st February.

LENT GROUP:

JOURNEYING WITH THE SHACK

This Lent, I invite you to join a six-week group exploring 'The Shack' through Scripture, prayer and open conversation. Each week, we'll use selected film clips as we accompany Mack Phillips on his journey through deep loss and his surprising encounters with God.

Together, we'll reflect on themes of suffering, grief and hope, and consider how forgiveness, mercy and trust can be rebuilt through life's most difficult times. Each session includes short film extracts, guided Scripture reflection and gentle sharing—no previous knowledge of the film or book is necessary.

Our journey will conclude with a full screening of the film on Low Sunday, 12 April, when the whole parish is invited to gather and reflect together on Easter's message of healing and renewed life.
