Chichester Diocesan Pilgrimage to the Holy Land 6 - 13 February 2023, led by The Ven Dr Edward Dowler, Archdeacon of Hastings.

Flying to Tel Aviv, the pilgrimage will take us to the Galilee region and then to the city of Jerusalem.

We will visit the key sites associated with Jesus's birth, death, resurrection and earthly ministry, and also have the opportunity to visit Qumran and the Dead Sea. This is the experience of the lifetime: the opportunity to draw close to Christ, to understand the Scriptures in a new light, and to have an enjoyable and interesting time in varied and beautiful places.

The cost is £1,995 if you are sharing a room, and £2,554 for a single room. This includes flights, hotel accommodation, coach travel, breakfast and dinner each day.
