### Lent Group: Journeying with The Shack

This Lent, join a six-week group exploring The Shack (film & novel) through Scripture, prayer, and conversation. Using selected film clips, we'll walk with Mack Phillips as he faces deep loss and encounters God in unexpected ways.

The Lent group offers space to reflect on suffering, grief, and hope, exploring themes like forgiveness, mercy, and trust rebuilt through life's trials. Sessions include short clips, Scripture reflection, and gentle sharing—no prior knowledge of the film or book is needed.

The journey concludes with a full film screening on Low Sunday, 12th April, open to the whole parish, to reflect together on Easter's message of healing and renewed life.

All are welcome to journey from sorrow toward hope and from brokenness toward restoration.
